Re: Reprimand

Gentlemen:

This letter is confirmation of the reprimand which was provided to each of you on December 15, 2004 in the Informal Conference conducted on behalf of the Louisiana State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (Board) by Investigating Board Member Mark Brown, with Board Executive Director Cheryl Gaudin participating.

This reprimand arises out of the following circumstances: Adam Brewer was practicing at Willis-Knighton Health System, Pierremont (WKP) with a temporary permit as he awaited taking the FSBPT licensing examination and then awaited the results. Upon learning that he had failed the examination on his first try, he arranged with Christopher Gilbreth for the required 100% supervision and indicates that he forwarded this certification along with an application to take the examination again and for another temporary permit to the Board. This request was not received by the Board and no new temporary permit was issued by the Board.

Brewer practiced at WKP under the supervision of Gilbreth from August 30, 2004 until September 15, 2004 without a license or temporary permit, in violation of La. R.S. 37:2404B(2) and Board Rules 321, 153C(1) & (2) and 155. Gilbreth failed to ascertain that the requisite permit had been issued by the Board. When this situation was brought to the attention of WKP, Brewer stopped providing patient care and charges made to patients for Brewer's services while he had no permit were reversed.

Brewer has now successfully completed the FSBPT examination and has received his full license from the Board. No action beyond this reprimand is deemed appropriate by the Board.
